We petitioned Tufts and requested an extension to apply to their Community Benefits and Health Equity RFP after they reached out to let us know that they had not received a South Boston application. They granted us 2 days – we put a proposal together – including all of the components discussed in our smaller SBANP working group session – which you were part of.

We were funded!

SBNH will take the lead as the fiscal agent.

The project - 'A collaborative response for child + family recovery' will include an expanded and coordinated network of services to positively impact the health of South Boston – our children and families.

The work will include:

- Celebrating Families a 16-week program for those impacted by substance abuse disorder
- Hope + Healing providing on-going supports and connections, resources and referrals for families impacted by substance abuse disorder through COASA
- Peace by Piece an initiative at 4th church (supports to expand)
- Professional Development monthly lunch and learn trainings offered to SB non-profit workers trainings focused on working with a trauma informed lens to better impact participants

We will be posting a full-time position to coordinate this initiative (Salary with benefits) -An email will be sent for those who want to be more involved in the initiative.
