Just a Start is a partner on The Seaport Circle project

- -Working with Bunker Hill on the project
- -The history of Just A Start was founded in 1968 by Gordon Gottsche as a youth training and community revitalization program in Cambridge's Welligton-Harrington neighborhood. Then turned more into housing development projects
- -Run housing developments mostly in Cambridge
- -Teach people the different housing process like affordable housing programs, assistance, mediation for tenant and renter
- -Talked about their biomedical training program and IT Sector (Tuition Free)
- -Small student body every year involved and they have seen instant raise increase within the employment market for those that complete the training
- -They partnered with Bunker Hill Community College
- -5 Day week program (9am:2pm) Fall to Spring Schedule (Study Body: 18)
- -Building a new state of art HQ in Cambridge (Redline Accessible)

-Partnered with Lincoln Properties (Parcel H) use some of the space for training that they offer in biomedical field (entry level)
